See Chicago's West Burton Place, a local and National Register Historic District. In the 1920s, artists and craftsmen led by Sol Kogen and Edgar Miller transformed Victorian buildings on Burton Place into the fanciful Carl Street Studios, using multi-colored tile, stained glass, carved wood and other materials. Zac Bleicher, Director of Edgar Miller Legacy, will lead the tour. Residents of Carl Street Studios will open their homes for an inside look into this fascinating enclave.
